Its second floor is a small hall equipped with an authentic Geisha entertainment stage and an "Ozashiki" party space to fit 32 people. The venue offers guests an opportunity to learn about the cultural history of the Kanazawa Geisha and appreciate the traditional Japanese musical instruments and equipment that are essential for the Geisha.

A perfect way to spend your 60 minutes to enrich your Kanazawa stay.

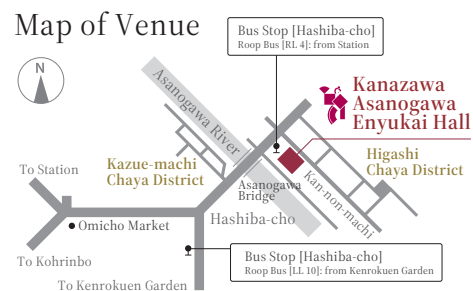
Indulge in the hospitality of the Kanazawa Geisha including:
